# LIMITED QUANTITIES

# Marking details:

Each side of the square-on-point marking must be at least 100 mm (about 4 inches) If a package requires a reduced-size marking, then the marking may be reduced to no smaller than 50 mm (about 2 inches)

For cargo transport units transported by water, each side of the marking must be at least 250 mm (9.8 inches)

### For highway, rail or vessel:



Limited quantities shipped by highway, rail, or vessel must display the limited quantity marking.

Proper shipping name or ID number is not required, unless the material is a hazardous substance or hazardous waste.

#### Mandatory for air (May also be used for all other modes of transportation):



Limited quantities shipped by air must display the "Y" limited quantity marking.

Proper shipping name or ID number is required.

## Package details (all modes):



Packaging must be strong outer packaging



Cannot exceed a gross weight of 30 kg (66 pounds) for most materials



Inner packaging depends on the material's hazard/division and packing group

### **Important notes:**



Labels not required, except for limited quantities transported by aircraft and poison-by-inhalation materials.



Shipping papers not required, except for hazardous substances, hazardous wastes, or marine pollutants, or if offered/transported by air or water (use "Limited Quantity"/"Ltd Qty" following basic description).



Training is required for those offering or transporting limited quantities.
